General terms and conditions

- The time for the wedding ceremony, including preparation and clearing up, is 2 hours; but it is possible to arrange the preparation and clearing up of things outside the agreed time of the ceremony.
- Wedding ceremonies usually take place during the museum's opening hours, which
 are from 10:00 to 18:00. If there is interest in organizing a ceremony outside these
 hours, there will be an additional operating fee.
- During the ceremony, the building will not be completely closed to the public (only the designated space); if the client wishes the building to be closed to the public, they will reimburse the operator for the lost entrance fees.
- The ceremony must be booked at least 6 weeks before the scheduled date. If the client wishes, it is possible to arrange a non-binding inspection of the place.
- The booked ceremony can be cancelled at least 7 days before the scheduled date (in the case of illness it is possible to move it to another date, on agreement).
- With few exceptions, it is not possible to provide parking on-site; for more information, contact the contact person for the building.
- Customs and traditions (e.g. throwing rice, petals, etc.) must be agreed with the contact person of the building.

Payment terms

- Price includes: renting a defined space for the specified duration of the ceremony.
- Price does not include: refreshments, decorations, registry fees and the registrar.
- Payment must be made at least 5 days before the scheduled ceremony date.
- The day of payment is understood to be the day the amount is credited to the National Museum account.
